BIOPHILIC DESIGN

Description: Biophilic Design is an approach that integrates nature with the interior, creating a space that supports the employees' health and well-being. It's based on scientific evidence, which proves that being close to nature helps you reduce stress, improves your mood and boosts your productivity. In this style, it's important to bring the users close to nature, which is in itself becoming a major trend, especially in the workplace.

Key highlights: Using plants in spatial design, e.g. green walls, vertical gardens and pot plants. Large windows to let in daylight, looking out on green areas or natural elements, decorations and textures inspired by nature (e.g. wallpapers with plant motifs), as well as water elements, such as fountains.

Textures and colours: Natural materials, such as wood, stone, wicker, and cork. Warm, earthy colours: shades of green, brown, and beige, as well as accents in natural tones to create a feeling of peace and harmony.

Benefits: Improved air quality and acoustics, which boosts comfort at the workplace. Biophilic Design has a positive impact on stress reduction. It boosts creativity, improves mood and enhances focus. It elevates workplace satisfaction, thus minimising absenteeism.




JAPANDI DESIGN

Description: Japandi is a style that combines Scandinavian minimalism with Japanese understanding of space known as “wabi-sabi”. In an office, Japandi introduces an atmosphere of simplicity and peace, which creates an environment that fosters focus and stress reduction. This style prioritises attention to detail, functionality and the use of natural materials.

Key highlights: Minimalistic, functional furniture, low tables, pillows for sitting, simple and geometrical shapes, clean lines and attention to detail. Japandi decorations are subtle and made of natural materials. They are often inspired by handicrafts.

Textures and colours: Natural materials, such as light wood (e.g. bamboo, oak), linen, cotton, and rice paper. Colours include mainly neutral and warm shades of beige, grey, and white, with subtle accents in black, navy or royal blue, to introduce contrast and elegance.







RESIMERCIAL DESIGN

Description: Resimercial Design is a style that combines features of commercial (eg. offices) spaces with the comfort of residential spaces. 

INDUSTRIAL DESIGN

Description: Industrial Design is a style inspired by industrial spaces, such as factories or workshops. It is raw and functional, and its aesthetic appeal relies on the use of authentic materials.



Textures and colours: Raw, natural materials, such as brick, concrete, steel and old or aged wood. Colours include neutral shades of grey, blue, and brown, as well as black, rusty orange and white accents. Pronounced contrast between materials such as glass and steel adds depth to an office space.


