



Each of basic areas in the office space (Work Zone, Meet Zone, Focus Zone and Break Zone) is composed of a few smaller MICROZONES - individual, functionally the smallest office space, building blocks of the entire office space to support specific activities.



Why Microzones?

The world is changing as we speak, and so are our needs, as well as the nature of our work and the type of professional activities we engage in. These new activities require a different setting and office arrangement.

DESIGNING DIVERSE WORKING AREAS IS THE KEY TO AN EFFICIENT OFFICE.

On a typical workday, we are engaged in various activities: we attend meetings (internal and external), complete operational tasks, work on a computer or devote our time to focus work in solitude.

We can boost our effectiveness at each of these steps if our office has special zones that support specific types of work.

But it's not only our tasks and responsibilities that differ. People come with different personalities and individual traits. We are neurodiverse - our brain is unique, there's none like ours in the world. Better yet, it keeps changing every day. That's why we need a different environment to thrive. Plus, some of us have certain special features and needs.

We come up with diverse microzones not only to boost the effectiveness at work. We also focus on the people's wellbeing, so that they have a comfortable and safe place to work in and feel their individual needs are addressed.

The material contains the following information about microzones:

FUNCTION	Information regarding the functionality of a microzone -what it serves, why it should be present in office space, and typically in what form it appears.
LOCATION	Suggested location of the microzone in the office space.
VISUALISATION	Visual presentation of a microzone - a proposed arrangement that can serve as inspiration
NUMBER OF PEOPLE	Estimated number of people for whom the presented microzone is de- signed. The number of employees may depend on the nature of the space arrangement.
AVERAGE USE TIME	Approximate, estimated time that employees may spend in a given microzone.
PRODUCT PROPOSITION	The selected product proposal fulfilling the functionality of a microzone.

THIS IS AN AREA OF THE OFFICE SPACE, WHICH IS DEDICATED TO INDIVIDUAL WORK AT A COMPUTER DESK. THIS IS THE PLACE FOR OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES, ADMINISTRATION AND TECHNICAL MANAGEMENT.

A properly equipped workstation should make it easy for the user to perform multiple tasks without putting excessive strain on the musculoskeletal system. It should support comfortable work without forcing the human body to assume unnatural positions. In the WORK ZONE, you will find the following MICROZONES:



FUNCTION: A basic individual workstation usually includes the same staple elements: a desk (with or without height adjustment) + a chair. An ergonomic workstation makes it possible for the user to engage in work for more than 4 hours a day. Each employee can have a dedicated workstation, or they can follow a Desk Sharing scheme, with more than one employee assigned to each station. Workstations can be connected to form workbenches (this solution saves a lot of space) or they can remain separate.

EXTRA WORKSPACE FOR EMPLOYEES OR CLIENTS

FUNCTION: An extra desk or a project table is available to all employees without the need to book it in advance. This is a solution designed for mobile employees or those who don't have an assigned workstation. Sometimes offices include a hot desking space for visiting employees, who come from other departments, or for visitors/ clients who need a desk on an ad hoc basis.

Managerial Rooms

FUNCTION: An individual office space designed for managers, CEOs or the board (premium). The arrangement can reflect the organizational structure of the specific business. This type of microzone supports confidentiality and usually comes with extra storage space (e.g. for confidential employee files). This microzone can be a combination of all office zones (and support individual work, focus work, and meetings).

Welcoming Zone

FUNCTION: The entrance area in the office space has the role of welcoming and controlling access, ensuring the security of employees and visitors. It is a waiting area, a short meeting place and a place where essential facilities such as registering appointments or receiving deliveries can be used. In addition, it is often the central workspace for Office Managers who manage day-to-day office operations. The entrance area is often the "business card" of the company, reflecting its culture and values through appropriate furnishings and arrangement. This kind of microzone is often complete with versatile mobile furniture so that employees can easily rearrange the space and adjust it to their current needs or activities.

Focus Zone

THIS AREA IS DEDICATED TO INDIVIDUAL FOCUS WORK, WHICH CALLS FOR SILENCE.



It is important to assign a separate space to focus work, which requires silence. Distractions, such as people talking and the office buzz, reduce our effectiveness by as much as **40**% and increase the risk of errors by **27**%. In the FOCUS ZONE, you will find the following MICROZONES:

- Focus Room
- Focus Spot
- Workpod

Focus Room

FUNCTION: This office area is designed for focus work, which calls for silence. It's good to remember that a Focus Room is actually not an individual office room. It's a space that can be booked in advance and is available to all employees, so it's a good idea to furnish it with intuitive and easily adjustable solutions. A Focus Room can also be used for online meetings and private conferences of 2-3 people. 





THIS AREA IS DESIGNED FOR CHILLOUT, LEISURE, REGENERATION AND OF COURSE, AS A PLACE WHERE YOU CAN HAVE COFFEE OR A MEAL. IT IS IN THESE ZONES THAT THE EMPLOYEES CAN DEVELOP INFORMAL RELATIONS. In the BREAK ZONE, you will find the following MICROZONES:

- Canteen
- Chillout Space



Having a meal is generally associated with warmth and care. It is in the kitchen that long conversations take place, as we prepare food, and holding a cup of hot tea makes us feel kindly disposed towards the world. Meetings in the kitchen reduce social distance and encourage deeper relationships.





FUNCTION: This microzone has a primarily social function. When it's big enough, it could become a meeting space for the entire company. It's a place where people come to have a meal, relax and engage in informal conversations. The Canteen is often combined with the Chillout Space, with a smooth transition to help the employees continue the conversations started during the meal.

To enhance the leisure vibe, you can throw in board games, darts or table football. Some businesses, especially IT companies, like to have gaming consoles and TV sets in this zone.


